Open Intermediate \$200,000 - \$749,999

Non-Pro Intermediate \$100,001 - \$499,999

Open Derby & Intermediate Open Derby: The Derby will be held in two separate NCHA WE shows. The number of horses paid will be based on NCHA payout. All Intermediate riders must enter the Open. The Intermediate is a class within the Open. The added money for the Open Derby is \$6,200 per show and the added money for the Open Intermediate Derby \$1,700 per class. The fee for the Open Derby is \$890. There is no additional fee to enter the Intermediate Open. The purse will be made up of the jackpot money \$500 split 80/20 – 80% going to the Open and 20% to the Intermediate Open plus the respective added monies. Those qualifying for the Intermediate Open will have two (2) chances to earn money – from the Open purse and the Intermediate Open purse. Awards will be presented to the Open circuit champion, Open reserve circuit champion, Open Intermediate circuit champion and the Open Intermediate reserve champion. A horse must show in both shows to qualify.

Non-Pro & Intermediate Non-Pro: The Derby will be held in two separate NCHA WE shows. The number of horses paid will be based on NCHA payout. All Intermediate riders must enter the Non-Pro. The Intermediate is a class within the Non-Pro. The added money for the Non-Pro Derby \$1,500 per show and the added money for the Non-Pro Intermediate Derby \$500 per class. The fee for the Non-Pro Derby \$740. There is no additional fee to enter the Intermediate Non-Pro. The purse will be made up of the jackpot money \$350 split 80/20 – 80% going to the Non-Pro and 20% to the Intermediate Non-Pro plus the respective added monies. Those qualifying for the Intermediate Non-Pro will have two (2) chances to earn money – from the Non-Pro purse and the Intermediate Non-Pro purse. Awards will be presented to the Non-Pro circuit champion, Non-Pro reserve circuit champion, Non-Pro Intermediate circuit champion and the Non-Pro Intermediate reserve champion. A horse must show in both shows to qualify.

Open 5/6 & Intermediate Open 5/6: The 5/6 will be held in two separate NCHA WE shows. The number of horses paid will be based on NCHA payout. All Intermediate riders must enter the Open. The Intermediate is a class within the Open. The added money for the Open 5/6 is \$6,200 per show and the added money for the Open Intermediate 5/6 \$1,700 per class. The fee for the Open 5/6 is \$890. There is no additional fee to enter the Intermediate Open. The purse will be made up of the jackpot money \$500 split 80/20 – 80% going to the Open and 20% to the Intermediate Open plus the respective added monies. Those qualifying for the Intermediate Open will have two (2) chances to earn money – from the Open purse and the Intermediate Open purse. Awards will be presented to the Open circuit champion, Open reserve circuit champion, Open Intermediate circuit champion and the Open Intermediate reserve champion. A horse must show in both shows to qualify.

Non-Pro & Intermediate Non-Pro: The 5/6 will be held in two separate NCHA WE shows. The number of horses paid will be based on NCHA payout. All Intermediate riders must enter the Non-Pro. The Intermediate is a class within the Non-Pro. The added money for the Non-Pro 5/6 \$1,500 per show and the added money for the Non-Pro Intermediate 5/6 \$500 per class. The fee for the Non-Pro 5/6 \$740. There is no additional fee to enter the Intermediate Non-Pro. The purse will be made up of the jackpot money \$350 split 80/20 – 80% going to the Non-Pro and 20% to the Intermediate Non-Pro plus the respective added monies. Those qualifying for the Intermediate Non-Pro will have two (2) chances to earn money – from the Non-Pro purse and the Intermediate Non-Pro purse. Awards will be presented to the Non-Pro circuit champion, Non-Pro reserve circuit champion, Non-Pro Intermediate circuit champion and the Non-Pro Intermediate reserve champion. A horse must show in both shows to qualify.
